Ambriel Cloud Ten 2010 En Magnum, West Sussex

Over a decade in the making, the Ambriel Cloud Ten is exquisitely decadent. Estate grown Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier grapes were harvested in 2010, and the wine has spent over 11 years evolving on the bottle lees.

Bourgogne Blanc 2018, Leflaive and Associés, Burgundy

Sourced from five biodynamically farmed, minute plots and owned by two sisters who have a particularly close relationship with the Domaine. Very floral and fresh on the nose. The palate is beautifully fine, in the style of a Côte d'Or white from Puligny.

Bianco Secco 2023, Giuseppe Quintarelli, Veneto, Italy

80% Garganega, with Trebbiano Toscano, Sauvignon Bianco, Chardonnay and Saorin, all co-fermented. Yellow flower perfume, with a zesty, green citrus brightness and a tactile bite from the Garganega. Quintarelli focuses on sustainable practices in the vineyard, ensuring a true expression of the terroir.

Flor de Pingus 2015, Ribera del Duero, Spain, En Magnum

Purity and freshness are the hallmarks of Flor de Pingus, allied to a certain old vine complexity. With an average age of 35 years, these vines have a deep root system, intensifying the wine's personality. Just 30% of new oak adds another dimension, a richness in texture on the mid-palate and finish. Flor de Pingus has been biodynamically produced since 2005.

Ridge 2018, Lytton Springs, California, En Magnum

The 2018 Lytton Springs is a blend of 72% Zinfandel, 18% Petite Sirah, 8% Carignane and 2% Mataro. The nose is lush and open, with aromas of aniseed, red and blue berries, blood orange and earth plus touches of tobacco leaf and dried flowers. The palate combines intense flavours with an ethereal, silty structure, and it finishes with loads of juicy layers.

Chateau Coutet 2016, Sauternes-Barsac

A beautiful aromatic complexity with notes of candied fruit, juicy yellow fruits and honey, it offers a bold, rich and concentrated palate. It has that Barsac spark.
